## **MOTION TO EXPEDITE HEARING**

COMES NOW Heather Williams, the Liquidating Trustee in this Chapter 11 case (the "Liquidating Trustee"), and files this her *Motion to Expedite Hearing* (the "Motion"), and in support thereof, would respectfully show as follows, to-wit:

- 1. The Liquidating Trustee has sought to engage the law firm of The Law Offices of Craig M. Geno, PLLC (the "Firm") to serve as counsel to the Liquidating Trustee in connection with general representation (application at Docket No. 3212) and as special counsel with respect to the pursuit of certain adversary proceedings and related claims (application at Docket No. 3213), collectively the "Applications."
- 2. The only objection to the Applications was filed by Dr. Michael Coleman and John Coleman. The joint objection at Docket No. 3242 (the "Objection") objects to both Applications.
- 3. There are significant deadlines that are fast approaching in this Chapter 11 case that require the services of counsel to not only file pleadings to meet those deadlines but also to investigate whether certain actions should be taken with respect to those deadlines. Moreover, the Debtor's affiliates have ongoing obligations.
- 4. The Objection is obviously a roadblock to those investigations and filings. Currently, the objection is scheduled for hearing on August 24, 2023, and there are deadlines which must be respected that actually occur prior to that date.

Objection.

6. The Liquidating Trustee respectfully suggests or requests hearings on any of the

following dates: July 27, 2023, August 1,4, 2023.

7. The hearings should not take an inordinate amount of time or preparation, but it is

critical to the deadlines that exist in this case that the Court hear, consider and rule upon the

Applications and the Objection thereto immediately.

8. Other grounds to be assigned upon a hearing hereof if necessary.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Liquidating Trustee respectfully prays that

upon a hearing hereof this Honorable Court will enter its order setting a trial date in connection with

the application and the objection at the Court's earliest convenience. The Liquidating Trustee prays

for general relief.
