The time, skill and experience utilized by counsel for the Debtor justify the approval of the Application.

5. This is the Applicant's first request for allowance of compensation for

professional services rendered in this proceeding. This request cover the period from September 27, 2021 to and including May 2, 2023, and is for the sum of \$14,630.00 in fees and \$251.28 in expenses.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Applicant requests that this Court enter an Order awarding reasonable attorney's fees for the professional services rendered herein and authorizing and directing the Debtor to pay said attorney's fees and expenses from funds Debtor's counsel has in trust.
